



CLINICAL TRAINING RESOURCES FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONAL STUDENTS

The Southeastern Primary Care Consortium, Inc. Atlanta Area Health Education Center (SPCC Atlanta AHEC) is a non-profit, regional health education organization serving Fulton, DeKalb and Clayton counties.



CLINICAL TRAINING SITES:

- We offer assistance with identifying clinical training sites and preceptors, particularly in areas of primary care. Note that there is a *high demand* for clinical training sites in Metro Atlanta, thus we encourage all students to join us in search efforts and let us know if/when they secure a site.
- For assistance, contact Preceptor Coordinator by email and provide the following:
 - Name, School, Health Professional Program, Current Year Status
 - Clinical Training Need (i.e. clinical area, county preference, date range of clinical rotation, and any specific requirements from institution)



HOUSING SUPPORT:

- In place of not having physical housing to provide students, we offer housing stipends to *eligible students*¹ completing clinical rotations in primary care (Dentistry, Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, OB/GYN, Pediatrics, Surgery) and non-primary care in Fulton, DeKalb, and Clayton counties.
- Housing stipends are available to all *eligible students*¹ attending academic institutions outside of Fulton, DeKalb, & Clayton counties and who complete a clinical rotation of at least two weeks in length.
- Housing stipends are provided **AFTER** rotation end date in the amount of **\$75** per week of rotation.



TRAVEL SUPPORT:

- We offer travel stipends to *eligible students*¹ completing clinical rotations in primary care and non-primary care in Fulton, DeKalb, and Clayton counties.
- Travel stipends are available to all *eligible students*¹; however, students attending academic institutions within Fulton, DeKalb, and Clayton counties receive *priority* consideration.
- Travel stipends are provided **AFTER** rotation end date in the amount of a **\$50** travel support check.

Clinical training resources are provided to students on a first come, first serve basis and availability is not guaranteed for any academic year. AHEC funding for housing and travel support is based on state and federal funds, community partnerships, and organization grants. Changes to availability of funds can occur during the academic year based on these funding sources².

All support funds are checks made directly to students and mailed to their mailing addresses.
